- * Do not smoke or eat in museums and historical buildings.
- * Do not leave garbage in museums and historical buildings.

Do not light a fire. Lighting a fire in natural areas can cause a fire. Therefore, lighting a fire is generally prohibited.

Be quiet and do not disturb other visitors. Natural areas are places to relax and enjoy nature.
